## CITY OF EDMOND . . . Large Item Bulk Collection

Up to 12 collections for bulky or large items are available each year for a nominal fee. So, there is no need to store large items or wait for spring or fall cleanups. The pick-up date is determined by your address and coordinated with the Solid Waste Collection schedule. View the Monthly Bulk Pickup Schedule Map below. Charges are \$10 per cubic yard for the first 2 cubic yards and \$5 for each additional cubic yard. Call Solid Waste Services at 405-359-4541 before you put your large item at the curb / roadside. You will be given the exact collection date and the fees that will apply. The fee will be included on your next utility bill.
