BULK COLLECTION in Cheyenne Ridge takes place during the first full week of each month. Charges are \$10 per cubic yard for the first 2 cubic yards and \$5 for each additional cubic yard. Call Solid Waste Services at 405-359-4541 if you need to discard large or bulky items that won't fit in your cart.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING: Christmas trees can be recycled by dropping them off at either Hafer Park or Mitch Park (watch for 2019 dates). Trees are chipped, and free mulch is available for residents to pick up at both parks so please remove all tree stands, nails and ornaments.
